MISSION: The Williamston Area Senior Center (WASC) shall be a "go-to" resource where aging adults and their families find support, guidance, educational, and social programs. These assist seniors 60 years of age and older to navigate life transitions and continue to be active, healthy, and engaged in the community.

PURPOSE: The WASC provides educational, enrichment, health awareness, and social programs while servicing as a resource for individuals needing assistance with medical and social service networks. The Center collaborates with other community agencies, local government, and trained professionals to meet the needs of the senior population. The center also seeks to inform the community of the philosophy of the center and solicit financial support for its programs.

The WASC is open Monday – Thursday from 9am – 3pm for card games, lunch and activities. Monday lunches are \$4 per person, per meal. Tuesday-Thursday lunch is provided by *Tri-County Office on Aging*, with a suggested donation of \$4 per person, per meal.
